- 1. Designation of players as 1st to 6th refers to the headcount rather than the individual players. For example, '1st Player' could play in Double2, single1 or Single2 so long as another player (anyone up to 12th Player) has filled the 1st space in Double1.
- 2. The names of the first 6 players arriving, <u>must</u> be entered on the scoresheet in any vacant spaces in the Triples, and likewise in the doubles and Singles (unless more than 6 players are present at or after the end of the 5-minute grace period).
- 3. Positions A1-A3 must be filled before B1-B3; A1-A3 respectively must be filled before C1-C3; B1-B3 respectively must be filled before D1-D3.
- 4. In summary, using up to the minimum six players, spaces on the scoresheet can be filled in the following sequence: A1, C1, A2, C2, A3, C3, B1, D1, B2, D2, B3, D3,
